On a mission to turn two old tower blocks on the East Bank area of Leeds into a collection of stunning starter flats, property developers Urban Splash were looking for more than the average substation – they were looking for an enlightened design.

Not ones to shy away from a challenge, we used our customary flexible approach to design a substation that would blend more easily into the architectural surroundings. Out went the more traditional grey stone casing and in its place came stone cladding and a screen to mask the substation.

Phase one of the development is now complete and sold out, with phase two close to completion and on schedule. Such has been the success of the partnership that Urban Splash has since awarded Energetics a second contract for a similar installation at Velvet Mills, Bradford.
